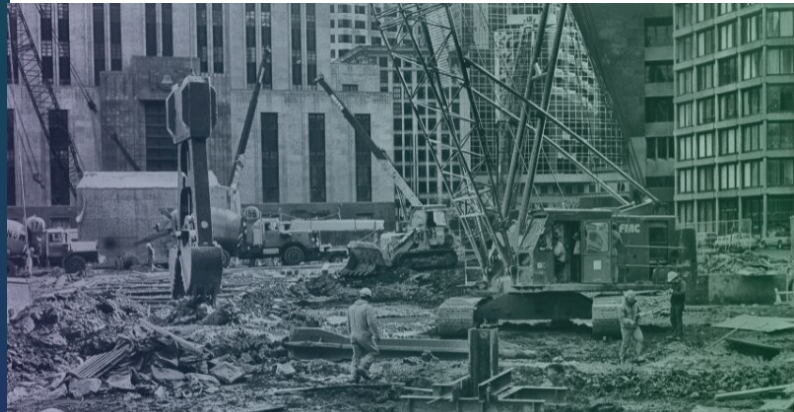

Supporting Children with Prolonged Illness

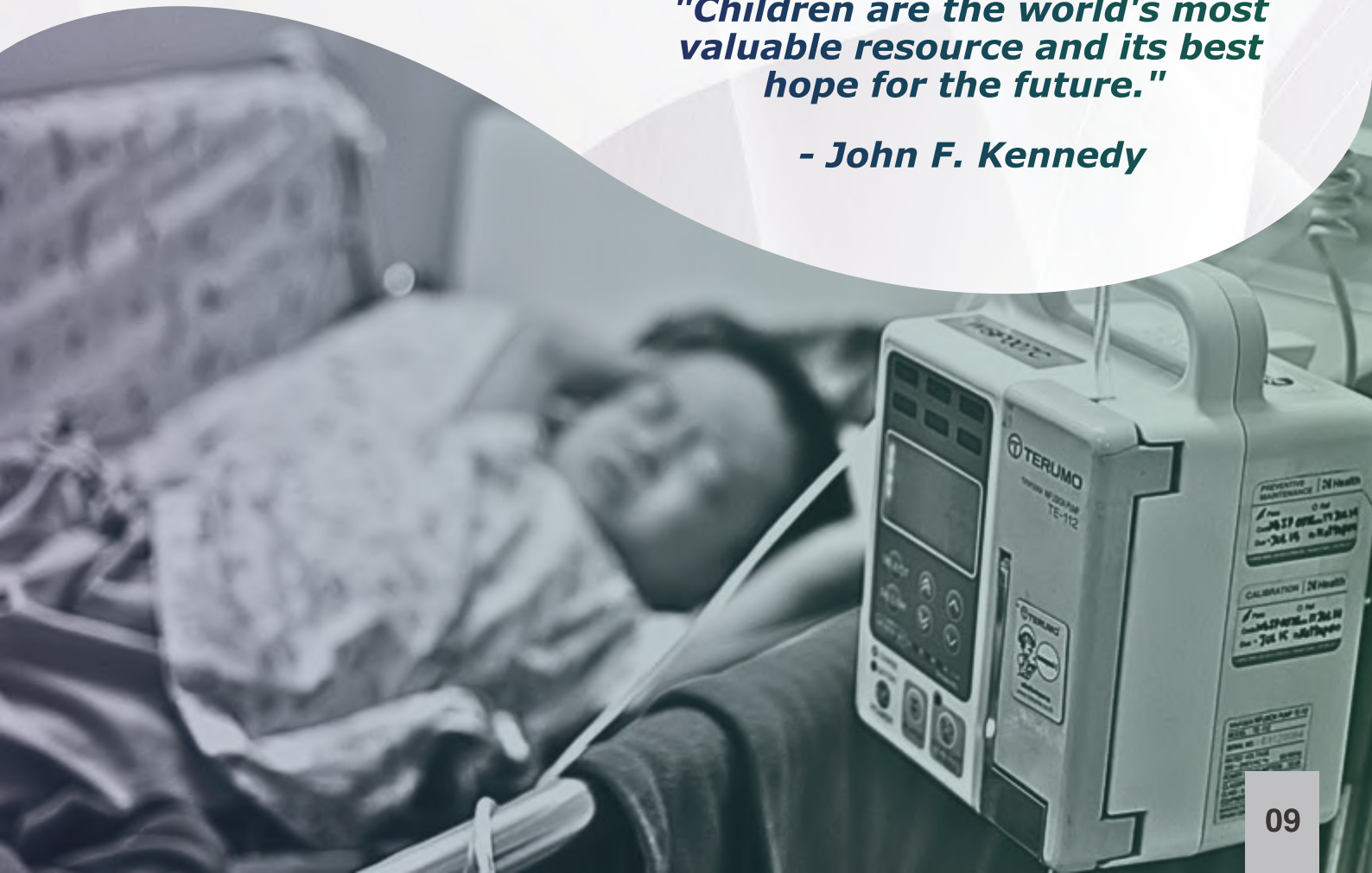

Common chronic conditions affecting children include asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, cancer, congenital heart defects, and autoimmune disorders. Long-term illness in children can have profound socioeconomic implications for families. Medical expenses, frequent hospital visits, and the need for ongoing care may impose financial strain and disrupt family dynamics.

It is evident that addressing the healthcare needs of these children requires comprehensive strategies focused on early detection, access to quality healthcare, psycho-social support, and advocacy for improved services and resources. Buimerc India Foundation (BIF) recognizes the critical importance of supporting children facing long-term illnesses and their families during challenging times.

Partnering with Solace, an NGO dedicated to caring for such children and their families, BIF aims to provide essential assistance and comfort to those navigating the harsh realities of illness.

Solace:

Through our Solace program, we extend financial assistance to families facing the immense burden of Pediatric Cancer, medicines and treatment expenses. This support offers solace to struggling families, helping alleviate the financial strain associated with medical care for their children.

ASK (Aster Sick Kids):

BIF has been supporting the ASK foundation of Aster Medcity for children affiliated with Cancer and/or in need of surgical interventions. BIF has successfully complemented the surgical costs for over 12 children, enabling them to lead healthy and fulfilling lives. This is a continuing process every year.

Educational Support for Children whose Guardians are under Palliative care:

In addition to medical support, BIF extends its assistance to the education of children whose guardians are under palliative care. Recognizing the economic strain on families dealing with serious health issues, BIF has supported the education of children from 30 families through partnerships with organizations like Pallium India.

Enhancing the Wellbeing of Nomadic Tribal Children

Nomadic tribes in India face severe marginalization, highlighted by government commissions and reports like those from NITI Aayog. Living on society's fringes, they encounter homelessness, lack of documentation, and limited livelihood opportunities.

Buimerc India Foundation (BIF) recognizes these challenges and supports initiatives to improve the well-being of nomadic tribal children, aligning with its vision of reducing inequalities and promoting social justice. BIF aims to create a more equitable society where every child has the opportunity to thrive.

Vanavil:

Vanavil, an organization dedicated to serving nomadic communities in the delta districts of Tamil Nadu works with the Boom Boom Mattukarar and Narikuravar, two nomadic tribes facing significant socio-economic challenges.

Areas of Focus:

BIF's support for Vanavil's initiatives encompasses a comprehensive range of areas aimed at promoting the holistic wellbeing of nomadic tribal children and their families. These include:

Sustainable Development

The team at Vanavil is ensuring holistic development within nomadic communities through initiatives focusing on health and nutrition, education, child protection, livelihood, and community empowerment. This involves ensuring access to essential healthcare services and promoting nutritional wellbeing, facilitating quality education for nomadic children to break the cycle of illiteracy, safeguarding the rights and welfare of children, creating sustainable livelihood opportunities for adults, and empowering communities to advocate for their rights and participate in decision-making processes.

Geriatric Care & Support Initiatives

India is witnessing a significant demographic transition, with the proportion of elderly individuals (aged 60 years and above) steadily increasing. According to the United Nations, India's elderly population is projected to reach over 340 million by 2050, comprising nearly one-fifth of the total population. There are significant challenges in India, including limited access to specialized healthcare facilities, inadequate trained professionals, and social stigma associated with aging.

Buimerc India Foundation (BIF) acknowledges this pressing need and has joined forces with Arike, an NGO specializing in Geriatric home care, to address it effectively. The collaboration focuses on bolstering home-based care services for economically weaker sections (EWS). Similarly catering to the nutritional and rehabilitative requirements of elderly individuals. BIF has been supporting social organisations like Akshaya Madurai. Akshaya Trust, a charitable organization dedicated to aiding the helpless and destitute individuals abandoned and suffering on the streets of Madurai, India. Committed to bringing peace, joy, and security to those in need, Akshaya Trust offers a transformative experience for rescued individuals.

Through these efforts, BIF strives to extend essential support to those most in need, ensuring they receive the care and assistance necessary for a dignified and comfortable life. BIF's collaborative efforts with Arike have resulted in the provision of vital support to more than 156 patients facing serious health-related challenges. This assistance encompasses a range of services aimed at improving patients' quality of life and alleviating their physical and emotional suffering during difficult times. By extending support to patients in need, BIF and Arike demonstrate a shared commitment to fostering compassion, dignity, and quality of life for all, regardless of socioeconomic status or circumstance.

Approach to Retinopathy

Kerala, often referred to as the diabetes capital of India, grapples with alarmingly high rates of diabetes, surpassing the national average by a significant margin. The prevalence of diabetes-associated complications, such as Diabetic Retinopathy (DR), poses a serious threat to public health in the region.

Buimerc India Foundation (BIF) recognizes the urgency of addressing this issue and has collaborated with Operation Eyesight on a project aimed at preventing blindness due to diabetic retinopathy in the Thrissur district of Kerala.

In Thrissur district alone, nearly one-third of individuals aged 50 and above are diabetic, with a significant proportion affected by DR and associated complications. BIF has helped 52 individuals from Thrissur, Kerala, who are in dire need of treatment for diabetic retinopathy.

The impact of this condition extends beyond individual health, affecting families and communities as well.

Unleashing Potential of the Differently Abled

Despite efforts to promote inclusive education, many differently abled youth in India face barriers to accessing quality education. According to the National Sample Survey Organization (NSSO), only around 57% of differently abled individuals in the age group of 5-19 years are attending educational institutions. Differently abled youth often encounter challenges in securing a employment and achieving economic independence.

According to the World Bank, the employment rate among differently abled individuals in India is significantly lower compared to the general population, with many facing discrimination and limited job opportunities. Access to healthcare services and rehabilitation facilities for differently abled youth in India varies widely depending on factors such as geographic location, socioeconomic status, and the type of disability.

Many rural and underserved areas lack specialized healthcare professionals and resources for addressing the specific needs of differently abled individuals.

Buimerc India Foundation (BIF) empowers differently abled youth beyond sports, offering vocational training for employment and personal growth. We have partnered with Adarsh Charitable Society, a 22 year old organisation facilitating the lives of over 450 children every year. BIF also introduced innovative programs like Horticultural Therapy at the facility. Our goal is to create inclusive opportunities, enhance skills, and promote independent living for all.

Cerebral palsy (CP) presents mobility challenges, especially in youth. BIF collaborates with the Cerebral Palsy Sports Association of Kerala (CPSAK) to support CP athletes through sports engagement and skill development. The aim is to raise awareness, nurture talent, and foster inclusion for individuals with CP.

The initiative seeks to identify and nurture talent among Cerebral Palsy athletes, providing them with opportunities for skill development, physical fitness, and personal growth.

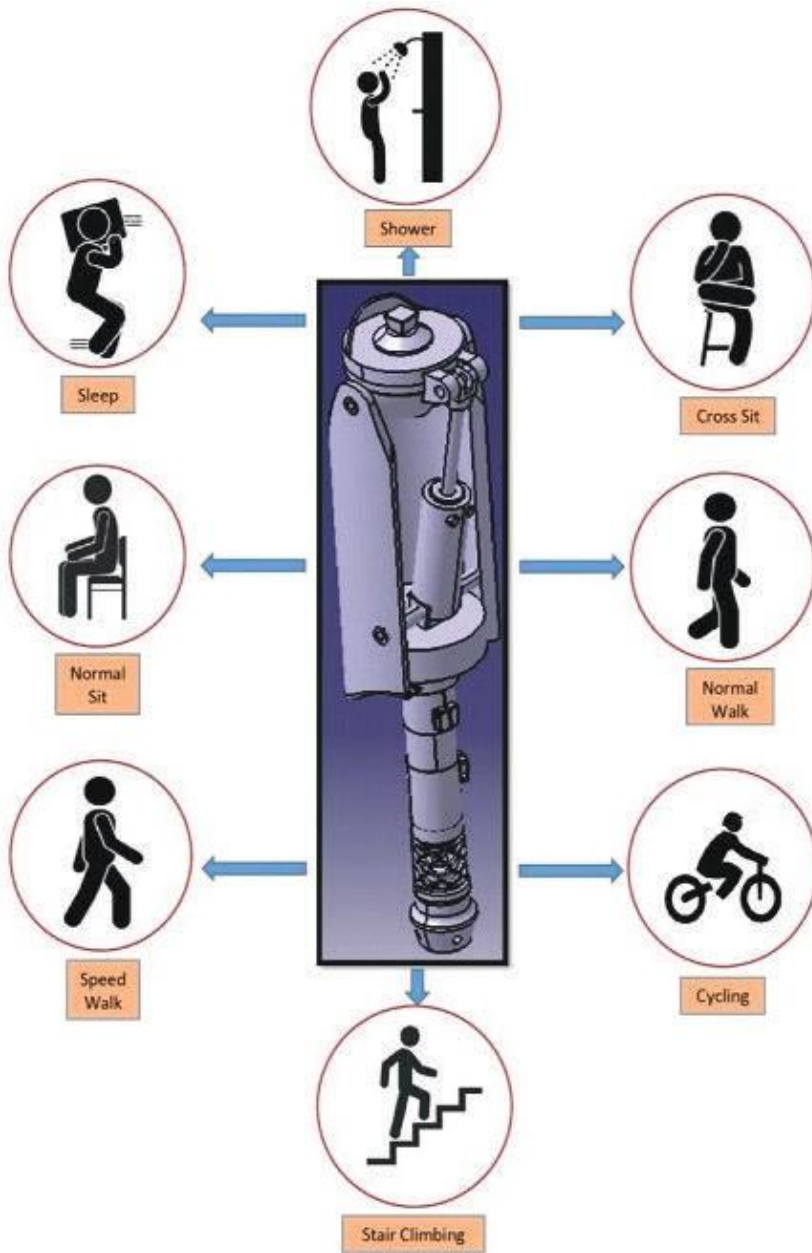
Competitive Opportunities:

BIF and VIT-AP Technology Business Incubation Foundation (VTBIF) recently signed a MoU at the VIT-AP University Campus on January 10, 2024. The focus of the MoU is to establish a center for Prosthetics & Orthotics for Humans and Animals (POHA) at the VITAP University campus. BIF pledged a donation towards a research project titled "Design, Development & Fabrication of SSW criteria based Trans-Tibial/Trans-Femoral Regenerative Effort Assistive Prosthesis for Youth/Elderly."

This project aims to address the challenges faced by lower-limb amputees in countries like India, where financial constraints hinder access to prosthetic solutions. The proposed model includes a low-cost pneumatic controlled biomimetic articulated passive prosthetic spring-loaded system for early and late swing and stance control knee, along with a regenerative effort assistive foot assembly.

This initiative aims to enable amputees to sit, stand, walk, and engage in daily activities at an affordable cost, benefiting the economically disadvantaged population. BIF and VTBIF are committed to leveraging research for societal upliftment and empowerment.

India is a hotspot for wildlife trafficking, with illegal trade in endangered species posing a significant threat to biodiversity. The enforcement of animal welfare laws and regulations in India varies across regions and jurisdictions. Challenges such as lack of resources, capacity constraints, and corruption can hinder effective enforcement efforts.

By promoting compassion, advocating for stronger legal protections, and supporting initiatives for animal welfare, India can work towards creating a more humane and ethical society for all living beings.

Supporting Stray Dog Welfare During Covid-19 Lockdown:

During the challenging period of the Covid-19 lockdown in Kochi, BIF extended its support to a local NGO dedicated to the welfare of stray and abandoned dogs. The NGO's volunteers worked tirelessly to feed and vaccinate over 1000 dogs, ensuring their health and well-being amidst the crisis.

Elephant Welfare Initiatives:

Recognizing the plight of injured, abused, and geriatric elephants, Buimerc India Foundation collaborated with Wildlife SOS Mathura, a renowned organization dedicated to rescuing and rehabilitating mistreated elephants. BIF has contributed substantially every year to facilitate the rescue, treatment, and care of elephants subjected to exploitation and abuse, particularly those forced to work in slums and crowded cities under deprived conditions.

With an intention to fostering a holistic approach, BIF's collaboration has played a critical role in implementing the Miyawaki technique of forestation, enabling Wildlife SOS to establish dense, native forests within the sanctuary and raise awareness about environmental conservation. This has helped create interconnected habitats vital for wildlife, combatting climate change by serving as carbon sinks and mitigating air pollution in Mathura.

Additionally, BIF also supported initiatives such as the purchase of tractors, establishment of a fodder bank, and extensive forestation efforts to create a green cover for the Elephant Sanctuary Rehab Center, ensuring a sustainable environment for over 30 rescued elephants.

Bear Welfare Initiatives:

Buimerc India Foundation (BIF) is focused on the rehabilitation of sloth bears, the eradication of the cruel practice of dancing bears, and the subsequent rehabilitation of communities previously involved in such practices.

One key aspect of our work is supporting the transition of these communities towards alternative livelihoods. By providing suitable training and resources, Willife SOS enabled them to explore and establish new sources of income that are sustainable and ethical. The project prioritizes the education of children within these communities, offering them access

to quality education that ignites new aspirations and opportunities.

Promoting Cow Welfare with Dakshin Vrindavan:

In partnership with Dakshin Vrindavan, BIF supports cow welfare. Dakshin Vrindavan's dedication to the rescue and protection of cows aligns with BIF's mission to ensure the well-being of these sacred animals. Through the provision of nutritious food, medical care, and end-of-life support, Dakshin Vrindavan cares for over 250+ injured, geriatric and abused cows.

Nurturing The Soul Of Arts & Crafts, Traditional Skills, Heritage & Indian Culture

India is home to millions of artisans and craftsmen practicing traditional art forms and crafts. While precise figures may vary, estimates suggest that there are over 20 million artisans across the country engaged in various crafts such as handloom weaving, pottery, metalwork, woodwork, and more. Artisan clusters and cooperatives play a vital role in preserving traditional crafts and providing livelihood opportunities to artisans. These clusters are spread across different states and regions, specializing in specific crafts and art forms.

Buimerc India Foundation (BIF) has undertaken a pioneering initiative in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Management, Udaipur, aimed at preserving and promoting art, craft, artisanal skills, heritage, and culture. The Craft Sustainability Incubation Program is a comprehensive, equity-free, four-month initiative designed to fast-track the growth of early-stage social enterprises in the arts and handicrafts sector, specifically those working with native and indigenous artisans of Rajasthan, Gujarat, and Madhya Pradesh.

Craft Sustainability Incubation Program Overview:

BIF-IIM Partnership: BIF has signed an MOU with the Indian Institute of Management, Udaipur, to empower 30 early-stage social enterprises working in the arts and handicrafts sector through a three-month, equity-free incubation program.

Objectives:

The Craft Sustainability Incubation Program is designed to achieve the following objectives:



Fast-track Growth:

Accelerate the growth of ten early-stage social enterprises through custom-designed workshops, continuous mentoring, and cross-learning from industry experts.



Digital Readiness:

Enhance digital readiness capabilities among artisans to scale their businesses effectively in the modern marketplace.



Market Access:

Provide market access opportunities to entrepreneurs/artisans through procurement relationships with a network of corporates, designers, and brand partners.



Access to Finance:

Unlock access to finance by connecting enterprises with strategic investors, ensuring sustainable financial growth.



Gender Equity and Cultural Preservation:

Leverage craft to increase gender equity, promote economic inclusion, and ensure the preservation and appreciation of cultural heritage.

Program Structure:



Residential Classes:

A 15-day residential program spread across four months at IIM Udaipur, providing intensive training, tools, and resources.



Coaching and Mentoring:

Four months of coaching and mentoring from domain experts, craft leaders, and business mentors to guide entrepreneurs in scaling their businesses.



Pitch Day:

The program culminates in a 'pitch day,' where participants present their ventures to an expert panel, including angel investors and venture capital firms.



Extended Support:

Upon graduation, the Incubation Centre continues to support selected enterprises for an additional twelve months without any additional cost.

Business Growth:

Ten social enterprises are expected to experience accelerated growth, building profitable and sustainable business models.



Digital Readiness:

Artisans will enhance their digital readiness, enabling them to reach new customers and expand their market presence.



Market Access:

Disaster Relief Initiatives:

Housing Rehabilitation:

Following the aftermath of the destructive floods in Pattambi, Palakkad District, and Idukki, BIF promptly initiated efforts to offer housing aid to the impacted families. Two houses were built for those affected by the floods, ensuring they had secure and stable accommodation during this challenging time.

Humanitarian Support:

Recognizing the urgent needs of vulnerable individuals, BIF prioritized the construction of RCC houses for families who faced significant challenges due to the floods. Rasia Faizal, belonging to a below-poverty-line family, and Shri. Rajappan, a paralyzed individual without a steady income, received essential housing support, enabling them to rebuild their lives with dignity and security.

COVID-19 Support Initiatives:

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Donation:

In collaboration with the Indian Medical Association Ernakulam, BIF donated 30 lakhs worth of COVID-19 PPE protective gear to frontline staff. This contribution played a crucial role in safeguarding the health and safety of healthcare workers battling the pandemic on the front lines.

Oxygen Distribution System:

BIF partnered with the CII Foundation to establish centralized oxygen distribution manifold systems in four Taluk hospitals, namely Peermade, Kunnamkulam, Pandapally, and Kayamkulam, during the COVID-19 lockdown. This initiative created 200 oxygen beds and 6 ICU beds, enhancing healthcare infrastructure and critical care capacity in underserved areas.

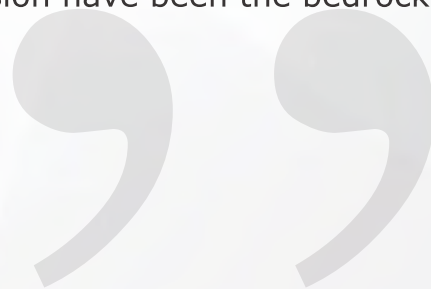

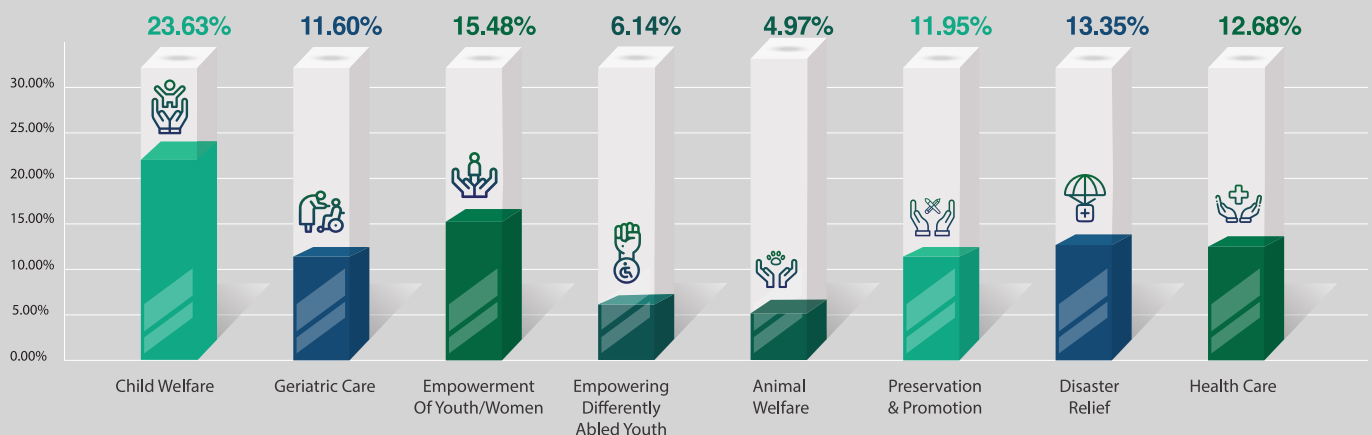
