These students, who were economically backward or had lost their parents were facing hardships in continuing their education. They were all supported with this fund irrespective, of their nationality. This had reduced the dropouts from the University and had transformed the lives of several families. Several students were beneficiaries of this generous support from the Buimerc group.
